## Regulations

1. No-judges will be allowed, except where noted in CWHJA rules.
2. ASTM approved hard hats must be worn at all times by all riders while mounted. 3. Open schooling will be Friday, June 10 from 1-5:30pm. Please pay \$30 cash or check payable to Jennifer Russell before mounting. A release must be signed. Controlled schooling will be allowed from 7:00 am-7:45 am both Saturday and Sunday. Schooling times on any one horse may be limited if others are waiting.
3. Only one horse per entry form. Entry forms must be transmitted electronically at [www.horseshowtime.com](http://www.horseshowtime.com).
4. CWHJA show management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or divide and class(es) should it be in the best interest of the show.
5. A one-minute gate and/or a posted order of go may be imposed by management to maintain a reasonable pace for the show ring. Back-to-back rounds allowed and encouraged. 7. Each class will award ribbons first through sixth place. Champion and Reserve will be offered for all divisions.
